GUIDELINES & RULES

1. All registered participants must have the Registration and Emergency Medical Form already filled out and kept by the church leader. Participants, who arrive after registration day, July 19, must register at the McDonald North Hall Lobby. ***Unregistered youth are not allowed on Campus***
2. Familiarize yourself with the schedule, topics and locations.
3. Check the bulletin board at McDonald North Hall Lobby for all messages; groups and subgroups have already been assigned during registration by your church. **NO switching between subgroups.**
4. (*) Every participant is required to attend all meetings (prayers, main topics, panel discussions, social activities and Bible study). Any participant missing a meeting will be referred to his/her church leader. Any two absences will be subject to disciplinary action.
5. (*) Main doors will be locked between 12 midnight & 6 A.M. Please be in your rooms before 11:30 P.M. Lights will be out at midnight. No males or females are allowed to visit each other's floors.
6. (*) Participants are not allowed, during the Convention, to leave the campus, or to use a motor vehicle.
7. (*) Any damage of property must be reported immediately. Those responsible will pay for the damage. **There is a penalty of \$50 for losing your room key.** Moving a mattress is not permissible. At the close of the Convention, each leader is to check with a College Staff the damage or the lack thereof.
8. (*) No smoking, consumption of alcohol or illegal drugs at all times. No food or drink allowed inside the gymnasium, auditorium or classrooms.
9. Appropriate attire is expected at all times. Absolutely no shorts or sleeveless tops will be allowed during prayer, meetings, or lectures. At the pool, appropriate swimsuits for a church group are required.
10. All participants are encouraged to share in ALL activities and make new friends. Do not wander alone: Use the Buddy System at all times.
11. McDonald North Hall Lobby will be the place for gathering from 10:00 P.M. to 11:15 P.M. for snacks; **ORDERS FOR PIZZAS** will be arranged.

DISCIPLINARY ACTION:

Participants violating any of the above asterisked rules (Rules #4 thru 8) must appear in front of a special panel to discuss the violation. The panel is made up of Bishops, Priests and Senior Leaders. The panel may decide upon a disciplinary action that could range from warning to probation, up to expulsion from the current Convention and/or suspension from future Conventions. We pray to God that we may never need to implement such disciplinary actions.
